Brushing teeth


Going places

To breathe

For electricity

Trees

What do we use trees for?

Food

We use fruits and nuts that grow on trees.



To build

We use wood from trees to build homes and furniture.



Paper

Wood can be used to make paper.



Soil

How do we use soil?

Crops

People use soil to grow crops. Crops are plants people grow for food or other needs. People in North Carolina grow many crops, such as sweet potatoes, cotton, tomatoes, and soybeans.





Fuel

What is fuel and what do we use it for?

Coal

We use coal to cook and heat our homes. Coal and other fuels are burned for heat or energy.
